



Distinct

- Quebec has its own RDC network (2 sites) : CADRISQ
 - Service d'accès aux données de recherche (SAD)
 - Houses ISQ data only
 - No administrative data
- 2 Data sharing is a sensitive political issue
- Some ministries have good research capacity
- 4 Specificity: FQRSC (SSHRC) Actions concertées
